

CHRISTOPHER McCARTER

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

April 3, 1821. be it known to all to whom it may Concern that I Christopher McCarter of the State of South Carolina and District York aforesaid being in a Weake state of body but of sound Mind and memory do make and ordain this to be my last Will and testament in manner and form as follows Viz

1st. I will and bequeath to my Sons Elias and George Alexander McCarter all the Land I am possesst of to be Devided between them in Suuch a manner that Each one Sahre will take part of the Cleared Land and of the wood Land to be divided as Equall as it Can having due regard to quality as Quantity and I Allow George A. McCarters Lot to include the house and other buildings where I now Live and to each of my said Sons Elias and George A. McCarter I give and bequeath thirty five Dollars to Each one in Specie-----

2nd. I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Mesinah thirty Dollars in Speci and two Cows and calves and all the Dressers and Kitchen furniture two feather beds and furniture belong to them also one bay mare and saddle and bridle and spinning wheel.

3rd. I give and bequeath to my son George A. McCarter A Negro Man named Joe, and I alow my said son George A. to pay to my son Elias one hundred Dollars and also to my son Robert McCarter ten Dollars.

4th. I give and bequeath to my son George A. McCarter a Sorrel horse in place of his mare given to Missiah.

5th. to my son Elias I give and bequeath one tan heifer. 6th to my sons James John and William I give and bequeath to Each of them Fifty dollars and I allow James all my Smith tools at their value in part of his fifty dollars appraised

7th. To my daughters Elizabeth Rosanah and Mary I give and bequeath to each of them the sum of five dollars.

8th I allow all the residue of my property at whatsoever Value and kind not herein otherwise Disposed of to be sold and the money arising from such sale after all my just Debts and funeral Expenses are paid in the remainder to be equally divided between my sons James John and William McCarter and also I leave to my Sons Elias and George A. McCarter each one feather bed and furniture and to my son George A. McCarter my Clock and Table...

And I Do Nominate and appoint my Sons Robert and William McCarter to be my sole Executors of this my Last Will and testament And I Do Disannull all other Wills and testaments in Witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal the Day and Year above written in Presence of us.
