

In the name of God Amen I Daniel Bartlett of the District of York and State of So. Carolina, taking into Consideration the frailty and uncertainty of this mortal life, and wishing to have my Estate in a Situation to prevent any dispute and to my own Satisfaction, do make and ordain this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made, and do dispose of my property in the following manner (Viz)

1st I leave or lend to my beloved wife Sophia Bartlett the full and entire use of the whole my plantation Whereon I now live for her use and her use only during her life, after her my beloved Wifes Death the plantation I lend to my wife during her life I give and bequeath and Divise unto my son William Bartlett his heirs forever during the term of my lease-----

2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife all of my Stock, consisting of Horses Cows, Hogs & Sheep, all of my house hold and kitchen furniture, farming utensils my part of the Crop, together with all the rest residue and remainder of my property of what kind and nature soever, to dispose of at her pleasure forever

3ly I nominate and appoint my friend Benjamin Furson Executor to this my last Will and testament I also request my Executor to assist Council and do whatever he may think an advantage for my Wife reserving the full right to my Wife to dispose of the property given to her as she pleases. I do hereby acknowledge this my last will and testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 22nd of February 1822
