Nuncupative Will

The Last Will of Daniel Simmons late of York District, deceased, declared by him ~~in~~ of mouth on the 28th December 1838, Elisabeth Flemming, Matilda Poag & James Isom heard the deceased say by word of Mouth the following On his death bed "That he wished some person to do some writing for him as respecting his Will but as they could be no person had, he called on the above named persons as witnesses, to His Will-His will was as follows he owed Mr Erwin Eight dollars, he wished that to be paid, the remainder of his Estate real & personal, be allowed James A. Sadler, to have, except his bed & loom, which he allowed Mrs. Fleming to have---

James Isom makes oath that he was present and heard Daniel Simmons, use the words above as his Last Will & Testament, & that the said Daniel Simmons called on himself & Matilda Poag & Elisabeth Fleming to bear witness to the same- that the words above were spoken in his presence and in the presence of the other witnesses, & that the words were spoken in the last illness of the said Daniel Simmons --Sworn to before me the 21st day of Jany, 1839
