In the name of God Amen This thirty first day of March in  
they Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen  
I David Jackson Sen'r. of the District of York and State of  
South Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind and Mem-  
dry and calling to mind the mortality of my Body and that it is  
appointed unto all men Once to die but after that the Judgment  
first of all I recommend my Soul to God who gave it. And touch-  
ing such worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless me with  
I allow it to be disposed of in the manner following (VIZ) First  
it is my Will and desire that my Body should be decently buried  
at the discretion of my executors Also I allow all my Just debts  
to be paid--Item I bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary Jackson all  
my estate both real and Personal during her natural life with  
the exceptions herein after named that is to say I Will and al-  
low my Son William Jackson the plantation whereon he now lives  
containing one hundred acres. Also I Will and allow my Son Hugh  
Jackson the piece or parcel of Land laid off for him on the low-  
er part of my plantation containing one hundred acres be the  
same more or less--I also allow each of my Sons nine in number  
One hundred dollars apiece--And it is my further Will and desire  
that my Son Elias Jackson Shall have all my estate Both real and  
personal at the decease of my Wife for his own use and benefit if  
he can make up one hundred dollars to each of my Sons as above  
Mentioned, and if he cannot make it without selling property I  
allow him to sell Perso. but none of the Negroes that I have  
raised do I allow to be Sold  
It is my further Will and desire that my Sons John Jackson and

William Jackson Shall have a Certain tract of Land that I am possessed of in Union District Joining lands of Samuel Davidson Jointly to be divided equally between them if they will take it in Lieu of the one hundred dollars allotted to each of them as above Mentioned and if they do not take it upon these terms I allow it to be Sold to help to make up the above Mentioned One hundred Dollars apiece It is also my desire that my wife should live with my Son Elias Jackson after my decease if She Should remove to any other of my children to live she forfeits all claim to my estate either real or personal upon her removal except one hundred dollars to be paid to her by my executors.

And for the execution of this my last Will and Testament I do consti-- and ordain my Sons David Jackson and Elias Jackson to be Executors of this my last Will and Testament. And I do hereby renounce al former Will or Wills heretofore by me made-- In Witness whereof I have Set my hand and affixed my Seal the Day and year above Written
