I David Johnston of York District South Carolina being weak in body but of sound memory and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die and thinking it probable that it may please God to remove me from this present World by this in disposition think proper to give and dispose of the property of which it has pleased God to possess me with at this time in the manner and form following

Imprimis It is my will that all my just debts and funeral expenses be all lawfully discharged--It is my desire that a vandue be made by my Executors as soon as convenient after my decease and all my property to be sold Item I do will and bequeath to my too beloved Sisters Eliza & Evalina Johnston as my Sister Nancy Woods Children & Brothers are better provided for all my monies arising from My Estate to be kept on interest untill they are married or become thirty years of age and then to be equally divided between them too Eliza & Evalina Johnston--And Lastly I do constitute and appoint my too brothers John & Robert Johnston & William Mason Executors of this my last will and testament by me heretofore made In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25th day of December 1824
