In the name of God Amen I David Neely of the District of York & State of South Carolina being in a weak and low State of Health but in sound mind & disposing memory & understanding Do make & declare this my last will and testament in maner & form following Viz It is my Will & Desire that there be One Hundred Acres of my plantation Run out by the directions of my Executors on the side of my Land Joining to Obediah Alexanders Land & Joseph Harts old line and that sd Hundred acres be sold at a reasonal credit and the price when collected equally divided amongst the following persons Vz My Son Jackson Neely My Daughter Mary McMiens wife of James McMiens and My Daughter Catesy Henery wife of John Henery and Alexander Brown the son of my beloved wife Each one to have an Equal part of the price of sd Hundred Acres of land-----Item as my son Thomas Neely is already provided for as far as will make him Equal with the Rest of my children I therefore allow the Remainder of my Land and all my other property to Remain in the possession of my Wife & my son William Neely until my Wifes Death They Speedily and punctually paying all my Just Debts out of the Same My Wife I allow to have a comfortable mentaintance on my Land dureing her life The Land I allow to my Son William Neely and his Heirs at my Wifes death I allow all the property then remaining the Land excepted to be sold and the amount to be Equally Divided amongst the following persons Vz My Son Jackson Neely My Daughter

Mary McTiens My daughter Catesy Henry My Wifes Son
Alexander Brown And My Son William Neely And I do here-
by nominate constitute and appoint Obediah Alexander
Executor of this my last will & testament hereby re-
voking and making void all former Wills and testaments
at any time heretofore by me made and do declare this
and no other to be my last Will & testament In Wit-
ness whereof I do hereunt s̄et my hand and Seal this
the 24th day of January 1816
