

In the name of God Amen, October 12th 1825 I Elizabeth Chambers Sen'r being of Sound mind memory & understanding & in usual health of body blessed be God for all his mercies do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner following

(Viz) First I will & bequeath to Edw'd R. Chambers son of my beloved son Jas. Chambers dec'd one hundred dollars to be paid to him by my Ex'rs hereafter named two years after my decease if he then be liveing Second I Will and bequeath to my Son John Chambers Benjamin Chambers & Samuel Chambers an equal share or division of the whole of my estate which is principally in three notes on themselves they paying to the children of Jane Adams dec'd and the Children of Edw'd Chambers dec'd two thousand dollars in the following manner Viz.

I Will & bequeath to Francis Adams Son of John Adams of Alabama John Adams Jun'r & Jane C McWhorter each two Hundred & twenty five dollars, and to Dursilla McWhorter widow three Hundred & twenty five dollars to be paid as soon as my Ex'rs conveniently can or in two years after my decease

I Will & bequeath to my Son Edmund Chambers dec'd four Children John J Chambers William Chambers Elizabeth Chambers & Nancy Chambers each two Hundred & fifty dollars to be paid to them two years after my decease or sooner if my Ex'rs conveniently can

NB It is understood that the notes I hold on my three sons does not bear intrust unless it is for my support while I live I will and bequeath to my Son Benjamin Chambers my Negroe Woman Slave Lavinia to be kept by S'd Benj'm or Harriet Chambers as long as they live & then to have choice of who she may live with after their death, She Lavinia to be appraised and what remains of

her Value over my board for two years past & while I live
and my funeral expences I allow Ten dollars of Said sum and
is to be Kept in reserve for my three grand children as a
remembrance of the named Jane Chambers Daughter of Benj'm
Chambers ten dollars John Chambers Daughter Jane ten dollars
& Sam'l Chambers Daughter Jane ten dollars & I further will
& bequeath to Benj'm Chambers daughter Elizabeth Twenty dol-
lars it is further my will & desire that my old faithful Ne-
gro woman Sill be Maintained & clothed by my three Sons and
I Enjoin it on my Ex'rs. to emancipate & Set at liberty if
they possible can the two Mulatto Children which I have bound
to Robert Wilson of Pendleton district in the State of South
Carolina (The Girl named Rachel & the boy Cornelius) Untill
they are twenty one years old which girl & boy I leave interely
at the disposal of my Ex'rs. Lastly I appoint my Sons John
Benjamin & Samueal Chambers Executors to execute this my last
will & testament
