wearing apparel and Judy large trunk and coarse bed clothing

7 It is my will that my Horse Cow farming tools ect. be Sold
and the money together with Three Hundred Dollars out of notes
due me be applied to the payment of my Debts

8 I leave and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Mariah Louisa
Hamilton whatever balance of money, there may be due me on notes
