In the Name of God Amen I Elfliday Bradley of the State of South Carolina & York District being mindfull of Mortallity Do this day make and publish this my last Will and testament in the manner following first I desire to be Decently Buried-- Allso first I give and bequeth unto my Daughter Mary P King one bed and furniture one hundred Dollars out of the other part of my Estate And allso all the Rest of My Real and personal property by legasey or dead of gift or any other way what Soever may Enorue to be Equally Divided between my two Sons Samuel Bradley & Joseph Bradley and I do he areby Apoint My Son Son Samumuel Bradley & Sherred James Sole Executors of this my last Will and testament in witness Wheareof I have heare unto Set my hand and seal this 16th day of December 1828 Signed Sealed published and Declared by the Sd testator as and for her last Will and testament in our presents Who at her Request in her presents and in the present s of Each other have Subscribed our names as Witnesses to the Same
