last will & testament Viz.

My soul I commit to God who gave it & my Body to the Dust whence it was taken.

Of my worldly property which a Kind Providence has committed to me I make the following disposition viz.

To my two daughters Nancy & Patsey I give & bequeath the sum of five Dollars each To my sons William & Robert I have already made right & given possession to that portion of my Land which I designed for them To my grand Daughter Nancy Nesbitt (Daughter of my son James deceased) I give & bequeath the sum of Forty Dollars to be paid her when she comes of age or at the time of her marriage. Should she die before this time It is my will that this sum be equally divided among my children

To my son Francis I give & bequeath all the Land of which I am now in possession On condition that he pay the sums above specified Provided so much be not derived from the sale of my personal property after discharging all just debts.

To my wife Jane I give the mare called Brandy also two Cows to be selected by herself also the Household Furniture. It is also my will that my wife get her support from my Land provided she remain on the plantation But should she find it more convenient to reside elsewhere I allow her the sum of Twenty Dollars to be paid annually during life from my land or by those in whose possession it may be. My personal property not disposed of above I allow to be sold & the proceeds after answering all just demands to be divided equally between my sons William & Robert

Of this my last will & Testament I appoint David Watson & my son William Nesbitt to be the Executors.

And in Testimony of my approbation of the above I hereunto affix my hand & seal the day & year above mentioned.
