to dispose of all Such worldly estate that hath pleased God to
bless me with do make and ordain this my last will in manner fol-
lowing that is to Say,

I desire that out of the money that is due me when collected
after my death, that all my Just debts and funeral expenses be
paid--

My will is that after the crop that is growing at the time of My
death is Gathered that all both my real and personal estate what
so ever Shall be Sold on a credit of twelve months, and all the
money collected and all my Just debts settled--That is Shall be
divided in the following manner

that is to give unto my wife Polly--the one third and the remain-
ing two thirds of my daughter Catherine's to be put at interest
untill She arrives at the age of eighteen years, and out of the
Interest of her part my daughter Catherine is to be educated un-
der the direction of my executor here in after named and lastly
I do constitute and appoint my friend Dagie J. McSwain (Jun) and
Elijah Hambriek Executors of this my last will and testament by
Me heretofore made in testimony whereof I have hereunto Set my
hand and Seal this 16th day of June- 1834--
