York District } trict aforesaid being weake of Body but
of sound and disposing memory do make this my Last will &
testimony in manner following, Viz

1st. I will and bequeath unto my Loving wife Margarett Riddel
the use and Occupaction of my Dwelling house together with the
halfe of the profits of the Land & Mill During her Natural
Life with the use of the housholde furniture.

2nd. I will and bequeath unto My Daughter Ginny Riddel and
Peggie Riddel thier Suporte oufe of My Wifes Margarett Riddel
halfe of the profits of the Land and Mill during My wifes
Natural Life And at her Descease I will unto My Daughters
Genny Riddel and My daughter Peggie Riddel Eache two hundred
Dollars to be paid oufe of My Estate togather with one horse
and Saddle and on Feather bed and furniture Each.

3rd. I will and bequeath unto My son John Riddel one hundred
Dollars.

4th. I will and bequeath unto Son Hugh Riddil fifty Dollars.

5th. I will and bequeath unto My Daughter Rosanna Bryson
fifty Dollars.

6th. I will and bequeath unto My sone Benjamine Riddel My
Lands and Mill with all My other goods & Chattels after pay-
ing the before Mentioned Legacies

7th. and I do herby Nominate and appoint My Son John Riddel
and My sone Benjamin Riddel, Sole Executors of this My Last
will and testemint. In witness wherof I have Set my hand and
Seal this 29th Aprill 1817.
