

In the name of God, amen, I Godfrey Beamgarde of York District South Carolina. being of sound ~~and~~ disposing mind and memory, but weak in body, and calling to mind the uncertainty of life, and being desirous to dispose of such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with, do make and ordain this my last Will; in manner following, Viz, I desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid, as soon as possible after my decease. I will and bequeath to my son Adam Beamgarde that part of my plantation known by Bennetts knob and Joining John Peters & Mrs. Watson, say one hundred and thirty acres. I direct that my son Isaac have that part of my plantation whereon my son Adam now resides say one hundred acres and adjoining the part allotted to Adam, and that the dividing line run through the spring and with the branch to the millroad. I also will to my son Samuel and Joseph that part of my plantation whereon the buildings stand say one hundred and eighty five acres, commencing on an ash corner on the creek thence down the creek ect. I direct that my son John have the remainder of my plantation and situated between Samuel and Joseph's part and Isaac's part. I direct that my executor pay to my son in law Archibald Harvy, Ten dollars as his part of the estate, that being all that I allow to him of my effects. I direct that my son Samuel have the young colt as his property also I direct that my household stuff and all my stock of cattle, Horses, sheep & hogs remain as they now are for the benefit of my children, who now reside with me during the life time of my dear wife, then an equal divide of my personal property between those my dear children that now are living with me. I will and direct that my son Samuel and Joseph support and contribute to the necessities of their beloved mother ect.

And lastly I do constitute and appoint my beloved son Adam
Beamgarde Executor of this my last will and testament, by me
made, and in testimony of which, I have hereunto set my hand and
affixed my seal this ninth day of July 1839
