The Last Will & Testament of Gordon Moore of York District State of South Carolina I Gorden Moore of York District & State of South Carolina do make ordain & Establish this writing to be my last will & Testament hereby revoking all others by me made & being of sound disposing Mind & Memroy at the time of Executing the same do declare my will as follows) To wit) It is my will & desire that all my just debts & funeral Expences be paid by my Executors hereafter named out of the money now on hand notes & book Accounts & the following Tracts of Land (To wit) The Land lying & being in Union District & State aforesaid known by the names of Thomas Blacks plantation John Parker plantation & the Joseph Howell plantation as also the following tracts of Land in York District & State aforesaid One Tract of Land that I bought from John Darwin Senr. One Small Tract including the Spring That Joseph Logan Makes use of That I bought from Amos Davis & if my Son John Gordon Moore will make a title from him to the Tract of Land that Joseph Logan now lives on to my Estate & let the Same be sold with the foregoing Tracts which I think will promote The sale of the adjoining Tracts Then my Executors Shall be bound to pay unto him the sum of One Hundred dollars if he agrees to the same in his own right Then I wish my Executors to lay of the adjoining Lands in Samll^{1/2} tracts to suit purchasers as my Executors as my Executors may think Best also my shares also my shares in the Howell plantation also a part of a tract that I Bought from James Flexco Comencing one Chain on the North side on the Thompson line where it crosses the said Flexco Spring Branch includ- ing the spring thence a streight line to the Howells Ferry line to the top point of the Stoney Hill Thence with Rhoda Smiths line

Mabel Smith line and said Thompsons line to the begining And if
the foregoing lands Monies Notes & Accounts & profits arising
from my plantation is insufficient to settle my debts my Executors
may sell the following Lands Beginning at Doctor Wrights North
~~West Pine Corner~~ from thence a straight line to Payton B Darwins
North East Dead Pine Corner Thence with Payton B Darwins line &
the said Doctor Wright lines to the first Mentioned Pine Corner
on Eighte tract that I Bought from Samuel Barkley the two last
tracts not sold untill it is ascertained that they others are
not sufficient all they aforesaid Lands to be sold on a credit
of one & two Years with lawfull interest from from Said sales &
secured by Mortguage for the payment of the same & my Executors
to Execute titles to the Same as if I were personally present
myself also all my surplus property that can be spared from the
use of my family & plantation I wish to be sold on a credit of
Twelve Months it is my desire that they will proceede of the pre-
sent Crop & the crops hereafter made after all necessary Expences
of family & plantation are first paid go to the payment of my just
debts if necessary if not the Same to be put at interest and that
my Executors have the power to rent any of my Lands if they it ex-
pedient & also to hire out my negroes yearly to the Carpenters
trade & any other of the Negroe men if they think it would be more
profitable than to work on a farm except my negroe man Frank and
all they hands that is now on the river plantation to remain there
except said Frank & wish the Bottom Lands to be cleared up from
the upper end of the field to the Mouth of the Goyen Moore Creek
& put in Cultivation for the Support of my family and the payments
of my debts my Negroe Frank and his son Jerry & the negroes that
is now on the plantation where my family now lives to remain there
to work said plantation under the direction of my son John G
Moore & for his Service County S.C. 18th of October 1822 he shall receive

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& put in Cultivation for the Support of my family and the payments
of my debts my Negroe Frank and his son Jerry & the negroes that
is now on the plantation where my family now lives to remain there
to work said plantation under the direction of my son John G
Moore & for his Services in Carrying on the same he shall receive
Two Hundred dollars annually from my Executors and that my Daugh-
ters remain where they live now untill the youngest arrives at the
age of Twenty one years or Marry by them attending to the domestic
Concerns of the Household & when my youngest Daughter arrives at
the age of Twenty one Years that all my property both real and

personal except Specified Legacies hereafter mentioned shall be equally divided by lot amongst they then Surviving Heirs or representatives And it is my desire that my Negroes be valued & put in lots & drawed for by the Heirs & that the land not be queathed to be sold or taken by any of the heirs at valuation & that my negroe Frank have his choice with any of the heirs to make choice to live with without being sold or divided

I Bequeathe unto my son William Thompson Moore all that I have heretofore given him of my Estate which will be found charged to him on my Books also one note of hand due from him to me also One Tract of Land That I purchased from Jacob B. Moore in Union District on Broad River adjoining the lands of John Moore & Susan Parker also one good Bed sted but not to have possession of said Lands untill my youngest Child shall arrive at the age of Twenty one Years

I Bequeath unto my son John Gordon Moore one Negroe Boy equal in Value to the Boys that William Thompson Moore & Jacob Alexander Moore has already received from me also one good Horse also one good Bed & Bedsted & furniture for the same Also I give & Bequeath unto my sons John G Moore Jacob A Moore (To wit) The following Tracts of Land the Tract of Land known known by the name of the old plantation given to me by my father lying in York District & State aforesaid on the East side of Broad River Also one Tract of Land bounded by Michels lines & John Darwin Dec'd. lands untill intersects with James Curriers grant at or near the Buffaloe stump Thence with said James Curriers grant untill it intersects with Daniel Smiths Land on the George Darwin Grant then with said grant the various lines untill it intersects with the old plantation also the part of Two other Tracts one that I Bought from Wilson Called the Henderson place & was granted to Joshua Denton the other Comecting on the Bentee line 1899 the East Side

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Daniel Smiths Post Oak Corner with his lines the aforesaid Lands
not to go into the possession of The Said John G Moore & Jacob
A Moore untill my youngest Child shall arrive the age of Twenty
one years then to be equally divided between in Quantity & Qual-
ity to Jacob A Moore I give one good Bed Bedsted & furniture
I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Minerva Moore when she ar-
rives at the age of eighteen years old one Negroe Girl between
the ages of eight & twelve one good Bureau one good Bed Bedsted
& furniture for the same

I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Temandra when she arrives at
the age of Eighteen years one Negroe Girl between the age of
eight & twelve years one good Bureau one good Bed & Bedstead &
furniture for the same

I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Diana when she arrives at the
age of Eighteen years one Negroe Girl between the age of Eight
& twelve years old one good Bureau one good Bed & Bedstead &
furniture for the same and Requist that they may be sent one year
to some good Boarding School & that the expences of the same be
paid by Executors out of my estate & when my Executors may think
that she stand in need of a Saddle & bridle buy one for her pay
for the same out of my estate I give &/Bequeath unto my daughter
Colnee when she arrives at the age of Eighteen Years one Negroe
Girl between the age of eight twelve Years old one good Bureau
One good Bed & Bedstead & furniture for the same & request that
she may be Sent one Year to some good Boarding School & the ex-
pences of the same be paid by my Executors out of my Executors

paid by Executors out of my estate & when my Executors may think
that she stand in need of a Saddle & bridle buy one for her pay
for the same out of my estate I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter
Colnee when she arrives at the age of Eighteen Years one Negroe
Girl between the age of eight twelve Years old one good Bureau
One good Bed & Bedstead & furniture for the Same & request that
she may be Sent one Year to some good Boarding School & the ex-
pences of the same be paid by my Executors out of my Executors
out of my Estate & when my Executors may think that she stands
in need of a Saddle & bridle to buy one for her and & pay for the
same out of my estate & I also bequeath unto her my Gold Watch &
it is my request that ever any of my Daughters may Marry that my
Executors furnish each of them with a good Horse and my Will is
that all the property I have given to my following Daughters Nam-
ed (To Wit) Minerva Moore Temandra Moore & Colenee

Moore Either specifically or by Division to them & the Natural
Heirs of their body and my will is that if either of my sons
or Daughters should die leaving no natural heirs of their body
their share or shares shall return to My estate & be equally
divided among the surviving Heirs or their representatives
It is further my will & desire that my aged Mother remain where
she now is and that particular care attention be paid by my
Executors to her ease & comfort & that she be decently supported
dureing her life out of my estate & charge the same to my Mother
and I do further give to my sons Jac G Moore & Jacob A Moore
fifty acres of Land for which I have Daniel Smiths Bond to make
me a title to the same lying between two Branches including my
Negroe Quarter but to not go into possession of the same untill
my youngest child shall arrive at the age of twenty one years
And lastly I do hereby Nominate and appoint my three sons William
Thompson Moore John Gordon Moore & Jacob Alexander Moore Executors
of this my last will and Testament and desire is that William
Thompson Moore be acting Executor of this my last will & Testament
and my sons John G Moore & Jacob A. Moore counsel & advise with
him in all cases that may promote the interest of the estate &
that my acting Executor make a regular return once in every year
of all my estate & the number of deaths & births of all my slaves
if any to be ordinary of said district in witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this ninth day of November
in the Year of our Lord Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred &
thirty nine
