At a Court of Pleas & Quarters of Sessions held for
Montgomery County on Monday the 17th July 1815

The last Will and Testament of Isaac Rogers deceased
was produced in Open Court another Signature to said
Instrument was proven in Open Court to be the hand writing
of Isaac Rogers deceased and that it was found among
his Valuable papers after his decease by the oaths of
William Lockert Joseph Caldwell and John Neville and Charles
Lockert David Bird, Sarah Rogers came into Court and were
qualified as Executors and entered into Bond with John
Neville and William Lockert their Securities, in the Sum
of Ten Thousand Dollars which securities were received
by the Court

In the name of God Amen I Isaac Rogers of the State
of Tennessee and County of Montgomery, being of sound and
perfect mind and memory blessed be God do make and publish
this my last will and Testament, To my beloved wife Sarah
I bequeath my whole Estate real and personal during her
natural life or Widewhood-It is believed that the use of
the whole Estate will be sufficient for the maintenance of
her and Children-if it is not and the amount should be
less at here decease or marriage or if it should increase
and be more than it now is It is my wish that the whole of
it whatever it may be at her death or marriage, be equally
divided between my children Narcissa Rogers Sally Rogers
William Rogers Louisa Rogers and my youngest daughter not
yet named I request my friend Charles Lockert and David
Bird together with my Wife Sarah, to be the executors of
this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby nominate
and appoint them for that purpose Nov'r 12th 1814 I.
