5th To my Daughter Violet Alisen & Bequeath the Furniture of one Bed

6th To my Daughter Elizabeth Jackson has received her Bed & Furniture

7th To my son William A. Barry I give & Bequeath Sally Dovey and Richard to him and his heirs also my stock of cattle and Furniture with the exceptions of one chest & Bedsted

8th To my Grand Daughter Margaret A Barry I give & Bequeath the chest

9th To my Grand Daughter Jane H. Barry I give & Bequeath the Bedsted

10th My wearing apparel I leave for My Daughters to divide as they see proper amongst themselves

11th In the last place I nominate & appoint my sons--John & William the Executors of this my last will and Testament I witness whereof I have subscribed my name this Eighteenth day of June One thousand eight Hundred & thirty Six
