Item 1st. To my daughter Martha Gallagher I will and bequeath my negro man Andy to her and her heirs forever. Provided however that My daughter Esther shall have half of the proceed of his Labour as long as she Esther remains unmarried but as soon as she marries she then ceases to have any further claim or right to the Labor of Andy.

I also will and bequeath to my daughter Martha Gallagher One bed and Furniture 1 Loom 1 wheel and cards 1 reel and all my cooking utensils. to her and for her own proper use forever

Item 2. To my daughter Esther Gallagher I will and bequeath one bed and furniture 1 wheel and one pair of cards to her and and for her use forever.

Item 3rd All the balance of my property consisting of my negro man Jim my cows & many other pieces of property. I direct my Executor hereinafter named to expose to public Sale as soon as convenient after my decease and the moneys arising therefrom after paying my just debts to be equally divided between my two daughters namely Ester and Matilda.

Lastly. I do hereby appoint and constitute Joseph Carroll Exe-

cutors of this my Last Will and Testament
