 stock of Cattle

To my son David Sadler I leave and bequeath all my money wh
 may be due to me from William Sadler his son--

To my Daughter Elen Black I leave and bequeath what may be due
 me at my Death from John Black her husband after my funeral
 expences are paid out of it as also my Debts

To my Grandchild Jean Sadler I will my Horse and Saddle and my
 Negro boy Sam--

To my son Richard Sadler I leave and bequeath my loom if he
 thinks proper to pay Ten dollars to my Daughterinlaw Elizabeth
 Sadler for the same

I also appoint my Son Richard Sadler my Executor
