In the name of God Amen I James Hogg of the district of York and State of South Carolina being sick and weak in body but of sound mind and memory do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following I give and bequeath to my son Alexander Hogg my bay mare and my gold broach, and to my son John Hogg I give my black mare and my silver spurs, And to my said sons Alexander and John Hogg I give my cross cut saw and all and every of my Mechanical tools of whatever kind share and share alike. And to my wife Isabella Hogg I give and bequeath all my remaining property of whatsoever kind not herein before devised with full power on her part to dispose of the same and use according to her own pleasure. ----

And I do nominate constitute and appoint my said wife and William Jamieson Esq. sole executrix and executor of this my last will and testament; hereby revoking and making void all and ever other will or wills at any time heretofore by me made and do declare this to be my last will and testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one and in the fifty sixth of American Independence-----
