 pences paid out of my estate In the Second place I allow as
 much property Sold as will be sufficient to procure suitable
 head stones for my father John Peters Sen. & My Mother Martha
 Peters Sen. Deceased graves & one suitable for my own grave

In the third place I will & bequeath forever to Sister Martha
 Peters Jun. the whole of the remainder of my estate real & per-
 sonal to be disposed of as she sees proper after my death
 Lastley I nominate & appoint my sister Martha Peters Sole Ex-
 ecutrix to this my last will & Testament

 nesses who has signed their names at my request & in my pre-
 sence have hereunto Set my hand & Seal the day & date above
