In the Name of God Amen, this fifteenth Day of January Eighteen hundred & Nineteen I James Pursley of the district of York and state of South Carolina, being Sick and weak of Body, but of perfect mind and Memory, thanks be given unto God; for the same, and calling to Mind the Mortality of My body & knowing that its appointed for all men once to die, I do Make and Ordain this My last will and testament; principally & first of all I recommend My Soul into the hands of Almighty God That gave it; and for My Body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a Christian like and a decent Manner at the discretion of My Executors; Viz My beloved wife Sarah Pursley & James MCord Pursley My Only Son to be sole Executors of this My last will and testament--Viz Namely I Will and bequath Unto My well beloved Wife Sarah Pursley the third of My Land during life and to have her due support of the Same--during her time here in this life; And at her decease the whole of My Lands for to be My son James MC Pursley; And Said James MC Pursley is to pay All My debts & recover all My Debts that In due Me--thirdly I will and bequeath Unto My daughter Jane Pursely One Cow And Calf, Side Saddle and bridle. And one hundred dollars in Money in twelve Months after My Decease; Also I Will Unto My Daughter Rachel M Pursley One Gray filley, & Twenty five dollars in Cash to be paid By My son J. MC pursley at my Decease--fourthly I will and bequeath Unto My Grand Daughter Louisa Pursley Twenty five Dollars when she comes of age to be paid My Executor James MC Pursley--fifthly I will and bequeath My household furniture for to be divided between My wife And My two Daughters--for to be divided between them by My Wife Sarah Pursley--Sixthly I bequeath Unto My Son James MC purley

All My stock of Horses And Cattle Hog & Sheep--And My farming
Utensils--to be his Except the Gray filly which I bequeath it My
daughter Rachel M Purley. Also My Rifle Gun & shot bag I will Un-
to My Son James MC Purley-- In testimony whereof I have hereunto

ten-----
