In the name of God, Amen I John Barnhill of the State of South Carolina York District being of sound and disposing Mind and Memory, but weak in body, and calling to mind the uncertainty of life, and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with, do make and ordain this my last will in manner following, that is to say--I desire that my wife Mary Ann Barnhill shall have and I hereby give unto her the Tract of land on which I now reside consisting of Between seventy & Eighty Acres also one bay mare six head of Cattle six head of Sheep Nine head of hogs with all house hold furniture which property I will to my said wife Mary Ann Barnhill with farming Utensils etc., during the time that she may remain unmarried, to dispose of the same as she may deem proper and at her decease to divide equally between each of my Children their heirs Executors Administrators & assigns to hold the same forever. And lastly I do constitute and appoint my said wife Mary A. Barnhill Executrix & my worthy friend Henry Carroll Esqr Executors of this my last will and Testament by me heretofore made. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal This thirteenth day of March In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six
