other wills and testaments by me made. And it is my will and plea-
sure that my Worldly Estate be disposed of in the following Man-
ner (Viz) First I direct that my wife have her support as usual
out of my Estate during her widowhood or natural life: and at
my Death I direct that all my Estate: both Real and personal;
be Equally divided between my four Children & no others: Viz,
William.. Clark: Mary Miller, James L. Clark. and my daughter
Harriet Alexander. to them their heirs and assigns-forever: Excep
that out of my Estate I direct that my grand son Pinckney Clark.
the son of my son John decd One Horse of the Value of Seventy
dollars to be paid to the said Pinckeny by my Executors herein-
after named. at the time of the division of my Estate between
my children aforesaid after my decease: And I hereby nominate
constitute and appoint my well beloved son James L. Clark; and
my son in law James T. Alexander Executors to this my last will
and testament--In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 25th day of January 1837-----
