In the name of God amen. I John Ellis of the District of York and State of South Carolina being weak in body, but sound in mind, do make, ordain and declare this to be my last will and testament revoking all others-----

1st To my dearly beloved wife Elizabeth, I give and bequith the Plantation on which I now live, with all the buildings, and household furniture, also Two Negros viz Garry and Mary, together with all the Stock I am now or may be in possession of at my deesease----

2nd To my Daughter Mary Quin I give one Negro woman named Dices and her three children Cloa, tame, & Ned

3rd To my Sons Edmund, and Stanford I give and bequeath three Negroes viz Rube Bonapart, and Rob, also a tract of Land known by the name of the Mill tract containing one Hundred and Sixty five acres more or less--

4th To my Daughter Huldah Dobson I give & bequeath one Negro woman named Isabella

5th To my Daughter Louisa I give and bequeath one Negro Girl named Rachel---

6th To my Son Albird I give and bequeath one Negro Boy Brison-

7th To my Son William I give and bequeath the the Negro woman Mary which I have given to my wife, after her death-----

8th To my Daughter Neomy I give and bequeath one Negro girl named Hannah

9th To my Daughter Dulcinea I give and bequeath one negro Girl named Lucind.

I do nominate and appoint my wife Elizabeth and my son Edmund

to be the Executors of this my last will and testament----
