

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

In the name of God Amen I John Falls of South Carolina and District of York, do make & publish this my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say first & will that my body be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my executors. Secondly that my just debts be all paid. Then I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth all the plantation whereon I now live (except so much as was formerly laid out for my son I. C. Falls amounting to seventy acres) Together with all my Stock consisting of horses hogs Cows and Sheep. Excepting what is below willed Also a Negro Girl named Esther a Bureau and cupboard also all my household furniture except so much as is hereafter excepted or willed to others of my family I also give & bequeath to my son Thomas the sum of one hundred & fifty Dollars & a Saddle & bridle worth ten Dollars, Also to my son John C. Falls the sum of five Dollars--likewise to my Daughter Polly Farris one Cow & calf one Bureau & cupboard the Bureau & cupboard not to exceed thirty two dollars Also I give and bequeath to my Son James the plantation I purchased from Benj Meely whereon McWhorters formerly lived together with two thirds of the profits arising from the Tanyard, the ballance of the proffits of the tanyard I give and allow to my wife Elizabeth, each bearing their proportional part of the expences for the same I also give to my son James fifty dollars & a saddle worth ten Dollars--

I also give & bequeath to my son Andrew a Bay horse named Dick together with a Saddle and bridle, Also I give and bequeath to my son Elam Amzi Seventy Acres of Land that was formerly laid off for my son L. C. Falls together with fifty acres adjoining the same it being a new survey taken up by Jordan together with fifty

dollars in Cash a young Wrangler filly And a Saddle & bridle worth ten Dollars--I also give & bequeath to my Daughter Drusilla a bed & furniture Bureau & Cupboard the bureau & Cupboard not to exceed thrity two dollars together with a horse sadle and bridle worth eighty dollars-I also give & bequeath to my Son Eli the land whereon I now live at my wifes death--I will & bequeath that the above named Negro girl named Esther & her increase at my wifes death be equally divided between my two Daughters Polly and Drusilla. I also will that my wagon remain on the farm for the use thereof. I also will & bequeath that the ballance of my property be put to sale to go to the payment of my just debts & paying off the heirs as they come of age. I also will that a piece of Land taken up by me lying between Venables old tract & Jas. Henrys land on whih Saml Farris now lives, be sold & go to the payment of the heirs ec finally I constitute & ordain my wife Elizabeth and my son James Falls to be the Executors of this my last will & testament in trust. In witness wher of I the said John Falls to this my last will & Testament set my hand & seal this seventh day of March one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven. Signed sealed & delivered by the Testator as & for his last will & testament in the presance of us
