mercies do make this my last will and testament in manner follow-
ing: I give and bequeath to my threer sons Legrand W, King Ingles
King and Joseph A King the following three negroes (Viz) my negro
boy Tom my negor Girl Nancy and my negro boy Andrew to be sold
(in this country) and the amount of sales to be equally divided
between them And to my said son Joseph A King I give and bequeath
fifty Acres of Land to be so ran out that he may have the east
end of the tract of land which I purchased of James Scott running
a line from North to South across the said tract so as to throw
the dwelling house on said tract where he now resides to him And
to my daughter Sarah L. King I give and bequeath my negro woman
Sarah And to my daughter Esther C. Burris I give and bequeath my
negro boy Harry-----

And finally I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth King
all and every kind of property both real and personal debts and
dues coming to me not herein before devised after paying my just
debts hereby giving her full power and controll with the right
in her self to dispose of the same at pleasure with full expect-
ation and desire that she will make an equal distribution accord-
ing to circumstances of her estate among her four sons (viz)
Ebander C. King James P. King Alfred I. King and Elzaphan King
this expectation belief and desire goes to shew the reasons for
my bequeath to my said wife--

And I do nominate constitute and appoint my wife aforesaid and
William Jamieson Esq. sole Executrix and Executor of this my last
will and testament hereby revoking all and every other will and

set my hand and seal this seventeenth day of December in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one-----
