John MConnel Senr of the State and District aforesaid do make and ordain the following as my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills Viz---

To my Wife Mary I leave all my property not herein after particularly named during her life and at her death to be disposed as I hereafter direct To my children I leave what property is now in their possess on of Negroes etc and make no further presion for them during the life of their Mother One half or Moiety of my land being the part my son- Andrew lives on and warked off for him I leave to him and his heirs forever The other half or Moiety whereon I now live I leave to my on John at the Death of his mot er or as soon as the the crop thereon grawing is gathered To my son John I leave One hundred Dollars to be paid him out of any Money I have on hand or out of My estate And at the death of m, my wife Mary I order and allow all the property then in her possession to be equally divided among my Children born of her who may be living at the time of her death the Negroes to be divided if conveniently and practicable without a Sale particularly them I have had born in my lifetime and wishes an arragement made by my Children not to put them to public sale but to purchase among themselves I appoint my son Andrew MConnel as Executor of this my last will and Testament Witness my hand and beal the day and date above written In presence of
