Sept 12th 1827

I John McConnel Senr of the State and District aforesaid do make
and ordain the following as my last will and Testament hereby
reVoking all former Wills Viz---

To my Wife Mary I leave all my property not herein after parti-
cularly named during her life and at her death to be disposed of as
I hereafter direct To my children I leave what property is now
in their possess on of Negroes etc and make no further prdson
for them during the life of their Mother One half or Moiety of
my land being the part my son- Andrew lives on and Marked off for
him I leave to him and his heirs forever The other half or Moiety
whereon I now live I leave to my son John at the Death of his
mother or as soon as the the crop thereon graving is gathered
To my son John I leave One hundred Dollars to be paid him out
of any Money I have on hand or out of My estate And at the death
of m. my wife Mary I order and allow all the property then in her
possession to be equally divided among my Children born of her
who may be living at the time of her death the Negroes to be div-
ided if conveniently and practicabae without a Sale particularly
them I have had born in my lifetime and wishes an arragement made
by my Children not to put them to public sale but to purchase
among themselves I appoint my son Andrew McConnel as Executor of
this my last will and Testament Witness my hand and seal the day
and date above written
