

In the of God Amen I John Mcfarlin of the State of South Carolina and District of York being sick and weak of body but of perfect mind and memory Thanks be given unto God Calling Calling unto mind the mortalitay of body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament That is to say principally and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend to the Earth to be Buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall Receive the same again by the mighty power of God; And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form

first I will that the whole of my Real Estate be sold in the following maner to wit to the highest bider the amount to be had in two several payments one half due in one year from the sale the other in two years and the money ariseing therefrom to be divided equilly among nine of my Children to wit Wm Mcfarlin Rebackah Harris Josiah Mcfarlin Wylie Mcfarlin Sealea Mcfarlin Ballitha Mcfarlin Peter Mcfarlin Richard Mcfarlin and Martha Liles to be paid to them on the day of their marage or when they arrive to the age of twenty one- and as to my personal Estate I will that it be sold in maner above discribed and the amount thereof after giving to Rebeckah Harris a Cow or the Value thereof to be equly devided between four of my Children towit Selea peillisha Peter and Richard Mcfarlin, and do hereby Constitute make and ordain Rubin Harris Executor of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 9th day of December In the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and twenty five
