In the name of God Amen -- I John Muldoon of York District in the State of South Carolina being in an advanced State of life and in a weak and afflicted State of Body but of a sound and disposing mind and memory calling to mind the Mortal State of my body knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die & not knowing how soon it may please God to call me by death do make this my last will & testament that is to say--First I resign my soul to God the giver thereof and my body decently to be interred in earth from whence it came--- And secondly as touching the small matter of worldly property of which I am possessed first I allow all my just debts to be paid and after that what small matter may remain I leave and bequeath it equally to be divided between my beloved sister Sarah Johnson and my beloved Nephew George Straight and Lastly I nominate and appoint James Poag to see this my last will & testament executed-- In witness whereof I have signed & seal this 15th day of October in the year of our Lord 1825 and in the 50th year of the Independency of the United States of America
