And as Touching such worldly things wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I give & devise in the following manner, viz.

First I give & bequeath to my beloved Wife Martha Peters for her Maintenance & Support the use & benefit of my Plantation & dwelling house & plantation  
 A utensils during her life time; My Stock of Cattle Sheep & Bees, All my Household Furniture Beds &c I give to be to be at her Disposal.

I give & bequeath to my Son James Peters Four Hundred Acres of Land including my Dwelling House & improvements to be by him Possessed in in his own right at the Decease of my Widow

To my Sons John Peters, William Peters, Daughter Mary Givins, My Son Jacob Peters My Daughters Jean Smith & my Daughter Margaret Huff To each of the above Sons & Daughters I give and bequeath the sum of Five Shillings Sterling.

I give & bequeath to my Daughter Martha Peters Two Hundred Acres of Land being a part of a Tract Joining M. Huff & Francis Adams & my Old tract.

And I do hereby Nominate Constitute & appoint my Trusty friend William Love & my Beloved Son James Peters Executors of this my last Will & Testament, and I do hereby revoke & Disannul all former Wills by me made & Executors by me appointed Ratifying & Con-
