 and the plantation she now lives on During her widowhood and all
 the Cubart furniture and kitchen furniture During Her widowhood
 Item I also will and bequeth to my sun Stephen Pettus the plantat-
 ion I now live on and a negrow boy boy Named Eleck-----
 Item--I also bequeath to my Daughter Hannah mary Amadah two
 girls each and mary and Also a bed and furiture--and a horse Saddle
 and bridle worth one hundred Dollanse-----
 Item I also allow mill and ealse to be sold and Equaley Divided
 Betwen the two Children and my wife and also the uper plantation is
 to be sold to pay my debts to the best advantage I also leave my wife
 to be an Exekertriks--this is my last will and Testament World
 Withthout End Amen
