First I Comit my Body to the Dust from whence it was taken And my Soul to God that gave it me to be Received by him through the merits of Jesus Christ my Lord and Saviour----

And as for my worldly goods which God in his Providence had been Pleased to Bestow on me I will that they be Disposed of in the following manner-----

First that all my lawful Debts be Paid

2 That my well bebloved Wife Sarah Ramsey Do Enjoy the Right of all my Moveable Property Including my wagon with all the Household furniture and She is to pay to my two Daughters any and Jenny the ten Dollars Each-----

3ly The Plantation whereon I now live Containing One Hundred and fifty Acres to be Left to my wife During her Life or Widowhood and then that it goes to my Son Thomas 4thly my will is that my Son David Shall have fifty acres of Land Adjoining where he now lives on the Right hand side towards his Brother Henery & My Will is also that my Son Henery Have for his part 50 acres adjoining His Brother David my will is that my Son Harvey Ramsey Shall have for his part 50 acres of Wood land adjoining the Plantation where he now lives Except A field on the Branch Known by the name of the uper field this is to be in his part My will is also that my Sons Alexander Abraham and John Ramsey have the Balance of my land that isto Say 150 Acres to be Surveyed and Divided into three parts that is to Say 50 Acres Each And when Divided Cast Lots for Choice of

Shares And Lastly I Doe hereby, Nominate and apoint My two
Sons Harvey and Alexander Ramsey to be My Executors of this
my last will and testament
