Smith Six negroes that is to say Bob Charles Bet Sindy Elmiry and Agg And a Deed of gift previously given and with this to be his Title for the same also one bed and furniture one large Folding leaf table and One clock and the case and half My Stock of horse brutes Cattle and hogs----- Fourthly I give Will and bequeath unto my Daughter Hannah Lipscomb Ten Dollars-- Fifthly I give Will and bequeath unto my Daughter Polly Gaffney Twenty Dollars----- Sixthly I give Will and bequeath unto my Daughter Amy Moore Twenty Dollars---- Seventhly I give Will and bequeath unto my Daughter in law Margaret Smith One Dollar----- Eighthly I give Will and bequeath unto Elizabeth Stevens One Sorrel filly now about three years old----- Then all the Remaining part of my personal Estate to be Equally divided Among my three sons Daniel A. G and J. G Smith and I do

and Joseph G Smith Sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament heare by Revoking and making void all and Every other Will or Wills at any time heare tofore by me made and I doo declare this to be my last Will and Testamnt in Witness whereof I the Said John Smith Have here unto set my hand and seal this third day of May in the year of our Lord On thousand Eight hundred and thirty one-----
