

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

In The Name of God, Amen, the 25th day of may ad. 1816, I,  
John Swann of the District of York & State of South Carolina,  
Being of sound Mind and Memory, and Calling to mind the  
Mortality of my Body and knowing that is is appointed for  
all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will  
and Testament, And as touching such worldly estate where-  
with it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give  
and dispose of the same in Manner and form following, Viz..  
In the first place I give and bequeath to Ann my well loved  
wife an honourable and comfortable maintainance of all my  
land and in the house I now live in, and my sorrel mare  
Saddle and bridle, her spinning wheel and her choice of two  
milk cows, and the Kitchen and household furniture to be  
Distributed as she thinks proper----.  
I give and bequeath to my Daughter Jane Vickers The third  
Division of my Land No 3, as laid off in as inclosed plot  
made by Joseph Swann Sen'r Wherein is mentioned her name.  
For her only proper use and her heirs forever--  
I give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann the fourth Division  
of my land, as marked No 4. in said plot for her only proper  
use and her heirs forever-----  
I give and bequeath to my son John B. the second Division  
of my lands as marked No 2. in the above mentioned plot for  
his only use and behoof and his heirs or assigns forever.  
And also all the Remainder of my stock of whatever kind,  
all my Farming Implitments together with all my Carpenter  
tools and Gun and Body Clothes.  
I give and bequeath to my Daughter FANNY E. the first  
Division of my land as marked No 1 in said plot for her  
only use and her heirs forever-----

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty son,  
John B. Swan & John Vickers. Executors of this my last  
will and Testament- and I do hereby Utterly revoke &  
Disanul all other Wills, Legacies or bequests by me  
before this time named;. Ratifying & Confirming this and  
no other to be my last will and Testament in Witness  
whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & seal the day and  
year first above written,-----
