 and District aforesaid do make and Ordain the following my last
 will and testament (Viz)

To my wife (Mary) I leave and bequeath three Negroes that is.
 Lindy a Negro woman Mary another woman. and Frances a boy child
 and also a note I hold on Andrew McConnell for One hundred and
 Seventy eight dollars and twenty five cents, dated April 8th,
 1836 and also a four wheeled Carriage commonly called her own,
 and two horses named, one of them Tom, and the other Fox, One
 half of all my household furniture, I also allow her, Together
 with one half of the kitchen furniture,- I also allow her to have
 the Plantation whereon I now live, to use as she pleases for her
 support, during her Natural life together with all the farming
 utensels and one half of the Cattle Hoggs and Sheep The Cattle
 Hoggs and sheep to be her own absolutely and forever. And I more-
 over allow my wife Mary to have a Negro Man named Elias and al-
 so a Negro Woman named Jude to work the farm and to use as she
 may think best during her life time and at her death Elias and
 Jude to go to my Nephew Minor Carrol--

To Minor Carrol my Nephew (Son of Joseph Carrol) I leave and be-
 queath the Plantation whereon I now live, I allow him to receive
 it at the death of my wife Mary (and not until then) I also leave
 and bequeath, Elias and Jude to minor Carrol to be received by
 him at the death of my wife Mary and not before- And six other
 Negroes I leave and bequeath to said minor that is Green, Polena,
 Thompson, Hicks, Betty, and Amy The above named eight negroes I
 leave and bequeath to the said Minor Carrol and the Heirs of his

body. I also allow said Minor to have the one half of all my household and kitchen furniture Together with all the remaining Stock of Cattle Hogs and Sheep not willed above to my wife and also all the Horses not left to my wife, together with every species of Property not mentioned above, ~~I allow the said Minor~~ ~~Carrol~~ to pay out of the above named Property my Funeral expences and all my debts

Together with Six hundred dollars which I leave and bequeath to my Brother Mathew Carrol (that is the above named property left to Minor Carrol) I also leave and bequeath my watch and shot Gun to Minor Carrol

In testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 29th day of april in the Year of our Lord 1838.
