knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and testament viz first of all I give my Soul in to the hand of God who gave it; and my body I recommend to the earth to be Buried in a decent Christain burial, at the decration of my friends; nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of god. And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give demise and dispose of in the following manner and form

I give and bequeath unto my two children Isaac Kuyhendall and Anna Carroll all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the District aforesaid and on Fishing Creek and its waters containing three hundred acres more or less Divided thus begining Just above the mouth of Wood's branch and runing a streight line through the land to the south of opposits line; the lower part to Isaac; and the upper part to Anna, I give unto my daughter Polly Smith my servant woman Eliza and all her family or increase; also my servant man Tom, To my daughter Edy Davison I give a negro Girl Ritty to my Daughter Sally Kuykendall I give my negro Girl Sintha, to the heirs of my daughter Elizabeth's Davison body I give my two little negroes Eaty and Losson; to my daughter Anna Carrol my negro boy Stephen and all my household furniture I give unto my son Isaac and daughter Edy and Sally and the heirs of my daughter Elizabeth's body and my daughter Anna my negroes David Mike & Hester to be equally divided among them my four above named children I will that my stock of cattle horses hogs crop and waggon be sold to pay my just debts. I hereby appoint

nominate and constitute my friend John L. Davis the sole
executor of this my last will and testament hereby revok-
ing all other and former will by me at any time heretofore
made. In witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and
seal. This twenty seventh day of September. One thousand
eight hundred and twenty six
