by almighty God for the same do make and publish this my last
will and testament in Manner and form following Viz. first I
give and bequeath unto My beloved wife Mary Neely her Mainte-
nance of of of the plantation whereon I now live as long as She
remains my Widow also one negro girl named Dine during her widow-
hood and if She should Marry then to be divided equally among
my children, all the household furniture, one bald horse and
Saddle, two Milk Cows, and one loom the rest of My property after
paying My just debts to be equally divided among my children
namely Peggy Eliz. Neely Thomas M. Neely, Jonethan M. Neely,
Nancy Amaline Neely and James C. Neely and as it appears at prea-
sant that My Sd. wife is pregnant and if the child live to Share
an equal part with My above Named Children, except My Sd. plan-
tation which I give and bequeath unto My Sd. three Sons and if
another one to be equally divided between them when the youngest
Son Shall become of age, a Sufficiency of the Stock to be made
use of for the Support of the family likewise of the farming uten-
tials, to tend the crop, also one horse named Tom, the remainder
of the Stock, and farming tools, together with one horse, fox
and waggon to be Sold and divided equally with My Sons and daugh-
ters, as they become of age the negrows to remain on the planta-
tion till the eldest Son becomes of age, to help to maintain and
School the children, and last I y as to all the remainder of my

personal estate of what nature soever I give unto my Sons and daughters to be equally divided among them, And I do hereby appoint James Carrothers My Sole Executor of this My last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by Me Made in witness whereof I have hereunto Set My hand and Seal this 26th Dec. 1821
