Neely and as it appears at preasant that My Sd. wife is pregnant and if the child live to Share an equal part with My above Named Children, except My ad. plantation which I give and bequeath unto My Sd. three Sons and if another one to be equally divided between them when the youngest Son Shall become of age, a Sufficiency of the Stock to be made use of for the Support of the family likewise of the farming uten tials, to tend the crop, also one horse named Tom, the remainderof the Stock, and farming tools, together with one horse, fox and waggon to be Sold and divided equally with My Sons and daughters, as they become of age the negrows to remain on the plantation till the eldest Son becomes of age, to help to maintain and School the children, and last 1 y as to all the remainder of my www.southcarolinapioneers.net
