The State of South Carolina York District I Joseph Boyd of the  
aforesaid being in my perfect sences & memory & in  
a common state of health but Calling to mind that all men have  
once to Die & of all Such Estate as God has been pleased to bless  
me with I desire to be disposed of in the Following manner Viz.  
I will & bequeath to my wife Mary Boyd the plantation on which I  
now live also three Negroes honest Jim Falls & Dinah to be her  
Property During her natural life the Negroes not to be removed out  
of said state without Leave of the Executors

2 I will and bequeath to Daughter Maryan Mannon ten Dollars  
and to my son James Lee Boyd two Negro boys Jep &  
Sandee allso one hundred & fifty Dollars in Cash

4 I will & bequeath to my four youngest Daughters Sally Jinny Clark  
Eliza Livena & Peggy all the Remaining part of my real & Personal  
estate to be equally Divided between them the said property to re-  
main the hands of the Executors Until they marry and then one Negro  
to be given each one as they marry or become of lawfull age in one  
year after the first one is married and Especial divide to take  
Place

5 I will & bequeath to my wife Mary Boyd one third part of all my  
house & kitchen furniture also one third part of all my Stock &  
Farming Utensils and Do hereby constitute & ordain this my last  
will and Testament I do also Nominate & appoint my Son James Lee  
Boyd & Robert Manner my Executors to Cary this my last will into  
effect In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this  
twenty third day of January 1822
