I Joseph Carroll of the State of South Carolina and District of York. do make constitute and ordain this my last will and Testament in the words following (viz)

Item 1st All my just debts of which there are but few and none of much magnitude to be paid off by my Executors, herein after named, as soon as possible after my decease.

Item 2nd. I will, bequeath and devise, to my wife Elizabeth Carroll during her natural life, my negro man Simon and his wife Philis, together with all my household and kitchen furniture, the house wherein I now reside and so much of my cleared land as she may be disposed to cultivate, And at my wifes decease I will bequeath and devise the property left her during her life to my son Minor Carroll, to him his heirs namd assigns forever.

Item 3rd. The balance of my Estate consisting of land, negroes, Horses, and other stock, farming, utensils, Black smith tools, & so fourth not herein above devised and bequeathed to my wife, I will devise and bequeath the same unto my Son Minor Carroll, to him and his heirs forever. In one word that my will may be better understood, I will bequeath and devise unto my son Minor Carroll the balance of my Estate both real and personal remaining after the life estate of my said wifes above set forth to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Lastly. I do hereby appoint my wife Elizabeth Carroll and my son Minor Carroll Executors of this my last will and testament.
