of South Carolina, being of sound and disposing mind and mem-  
ory, but weak in body, and calling to mind the uncertainty  
of life and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly es-  
tate as it hath pleased God to bless me with, do make and or-  
dain this my last Will in manner following that is to say:  
I desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid  
by my executors hereinafter named out of my estate  
After my debts and funeral expenses be paid I give to my wife  
Mary Gabbie one third part of my estate as well real as person-  
al for and during the term of her natural life, and after her  
decease I give the same to my five daughters Mary Perce, Ur-  
cilla Garvin, Salina Owens, Eliza Gabbie and Matilda Gabbie to  
be equally div'ed amongst them, their heirs forever  
I give to my daughter Mary Perce one hundred Acres of land where-  
on she now lives, Also one hundred acres of land lying and be-  
ing at and arround what we usually call the Still house branch  
to my daughter Urcilla to them, their heirs forever  
I give to my two granddaughters Elizabeth B and Marget one Seven-  
th part of all the remainder of my estate either real or personel  
and also one sixth part of what I have before devised to my wife  
at her decease they both, said Elisabeth B and Marget jointly  
shall have with their five Aunts before named at the death of my  
Wife which devise shall be divided into six equal shares amongst  
my five said Daughters and my two said granddaughters my two said  
granddaughters shall have but one sixth part equally divided  
between them both and to their heirs forever  
I give to my son Joseph Gabbie that tract of land that I usually  
call my Saw mill place liing north of east from my manson house

the Seat on which I first built my Cotten Gin and if he dies without Issue the same shall be divided between my five aforesaid daughters and my two afforesaid Granddaughters jointly they shall have one sixth part divided between them, both to have and possess for ever  $\frac{1}{2}$  my five afforesaid daughters shall have five sixth of the wole of this said devise equally divided between them and my two said Granddaughters one sixth part of said devise equally divided between them both

And I also devise that all my personal estate be sold at public auction and after my wife shall have had her third divided and given to her as before said or devised, I then give to my grandson Robert W the son of my daughter Rachl who is deceased six hundred dollars with all the interest on said amount from her decease untill it is settled and the remainder to be equally divided between my five daughters and jointly one sixth part to my two granddaughters equally between them to them all and their heirs forever

And lastly I do constitute and appoint my said wife executrix and my son-in-law James H Owans executor of this my last will and testament by me hertofore made in testamony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty third day of September and in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty five
