In the name of God Amen- I Joseph Jackson, farmer of The District of York South Carolina being in perfect health of body but of sound mind and Memory thanks be given to God-Calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die-Do make and ordain This my last will and Testament That is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my Soul unto the Hand of Almighty God that gave it and my body I Recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent christian burial at the discretion of my executrix- Nothing Doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Mighty power of God and as Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give, devise and dispose of in the following manner and First-I give and bequeath to Elizabeth my dearlybeloved wife full power and authority to settle all my Just Debts out of my personal Estate Item 2 I give and bequeath to Elizabeth my beloved wife, all my Estate together with all my household goods and moveable effects Item 3. I also give to Elizabeth my well beloved wife whom I likewise Constitute make and ordain the sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament all and singular my Lands messuages and Tenants by her freely to be possessed and enjoyed And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disanuls all and every other former Testaments wills Legacies bequests and ex-ecutors by me in any ways before Named Will and Bequeathed Ratify ing and confirming this and no other to be my last will and
