I have to die but being in health of body and of sound mind and
memory praised be God for the same do make this my last will
and testament in manner following I give and bequeath to my lov-
ing wife Rebeca Eighty dollars to be Levied of my Estate also
the one half of my house hold furniture and her Living off my
land Whilst she Lives on it also the use of all my Negroes
whilst she Lives if she thinks proper to keep them on the place
at her death or Removal of the Land the same Valued or sold with
all the rest of my property and the one half of the price of the
Land that I now Live on or the half of the Land I give to my son
James McKenzie also two of my Negroes named Abner and Lila to him
and his lawful heirs and their issue also I give to my son Robert
McKenzie one Negro girl Betsy also I give to my Daughter Marther
Boggs my Negro girl Sabrina to be for her and her heirs ~~ever~~
also I give to my daughter Grizzel McCall my Negro girl Sinda
also I give my son James Two hundred dollars to be Levied off
my Estate also I give to my soninlaw Thomas Howe a lease of
a tract of land that I have lying in the flat rocks for the
term of ten years or longer at the discretion of my Est. for
his Share I also give my son Joseph McKenzie all my carpenter
tools and the Remainder of my property to be Equally Devided
between my sons Joseph Hezekiah and Samuel McKenzie and my
Daughters Anne Howe Martha Brison and Martha Boggs and I do

Appoint and ordain my Sons Joseph and James to be the Executors
of this my Last Will and testament, this twentieth day of Jan-
uary A. D. 1821
