 one tea table all the remainder of Beds & Bed clothes-one chest-
 one Negro-girl Hanna-Buck on the New testament and the other half
 of all my share of the Cattle Sheep & Hogs. Also One hundred
 Dollars in Cash and all my wearing apparel and every other article
 not specified in this Will to my Daughter Sarah

3 I will & Bequeath to my Grand daughters Mary Barnhill One Negro
 Woman Named Lynn-and in consideration of which she is to pay over
 to her Brothers & Sisters and equal dividend of sixty six Dollars
 thirty three & one third cents in the space of two years after she
 comes in Possession of sd Negro woman Lynn this to be paid room
 of my son Francis-

4th I will & Bequeath to my son William the note of Honce I hold
 against him- of which he is to pay over to Francis my son -
 thirty three dollars thirty three & one third cents in the space of
 two years after my decease-

5th I will & Bequeath to my Grand daughter Nancy Melissa my spin-
 ning wheel & fifty Dollars in Cash.

6 I will & Bequeath to my Grand daughter Poley C. Armstrong
(Williams Daughter Ten Dollars in cash

7 I will and Bequeath to my Grand daughter Poley Armstrong
(Francis' Daughter Ten Dollars in cash to be applied to her own
especial use.

8 I will and bequeath to my Grand daughter Cynthia Barnhill
Ten Dollars in Cash-
