

In the name of God Amen. I, Mary Hemphill of the District of York and State of So. Carolina, being weak of Body off ~~Sound~~ and a disposing mind, Memory, and understanding; Considering the certainty of Death, and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous of Settling my worldly affairs, and be prepared to leave this World when it pleaseth God to call me hence; Do therefore make and publish this my last Will & Testament; in mannder and form as follows

First and principally I commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my Body to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my friends and after my debts and funeral charges are paid I I devise and bequeath as follows

Secondly, Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Robert Hemphill the sum of one dollars to be paid to him by my executors hereafter named.

Item I give unto my grand Daughter Jane Hemphill daughter of my son Roberts one Negro Boy named George & also give unto said negro George one Bed Tick two blankets on counterpane & one Sheet and on pewter plate

Item I give and bequeath unto my son James Hemphill one Negro girl called Easter one white sheet & one pewter bason

Item I give unto my grandson James A. Hemphill son of James one Negro child called Green also one white sheet.

Item I give & request that my Negro woman Amy be valued by three free holders, and that my son James Hemhill take her as the valuation and her value be equally divided between the children of my son Samuel by his first marriage; and the children of my son James.

Item I give unto my grandson James H. Hemphill son of Samuel one Negro Boy named ~~with said~~ ~~sign~~ to remain in possession of

my son Samuel until James Becomes Twenty one years of age and then delivered to him all the said willad property not otherwise named to be delivered by my executors at my Death

I give unto my son Samuels Three youngest Sons one Misk cow & calf and one Heiffer and all my Stock of Hogs at present thirteen head & one stand cuttains

Item I give unto my grand son Son Alexander H. Hemphill Samuels son or Walnut table.

Item I give unto myn Son Samuel one White Sheet also one Pewter Bason

Item I give unto my daughter Jane wife of Wm Porter the sum of one dollar to be paid to her by my Executors

Item I bequeath unto the heirs of my son the sum of one Dolar Each to be paid by my Executors

Item It is my request that all loose property found at my Death not named in the will be put to Sale by my Executors to pay expenses that may occur

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Daniel M. Shaw and Laban Suggs as executors of this my last will and Testament revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made ratffying and confirming this; and none other to be my last will and testament in testimony whereof I have Hereunto set my hand and Seal this 29th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & thirty three in presence of
