Riddle and John Albert Riddle, share and share alike, (the child or children of a child of the said Robert B. Riddle who may predecease my husband George L. Riddle, to stand and take in the place of his her or their parent) to them and their heirs forever, but charged nevertheless with the support and maintenance of my son Robert B. Riddle and of my said son's wife Nancy J. C. Riddle for and during the terms of their respective natural lives,-

Third- I hereby appoint my husband George L. Riddle and my son Robert B. Riddle

as my sole and lawful executor and reposing special confidence in

Third- I hereby appoint my husband George L. Riddle and my son Robert B. Riddle Executors of this my last will and testament and reposing special confidence in each of them, it is my will and desire that neither of them be required to give bond, for their faithful management of my estate, committed to their care- Hereby revoking any and all wills and codicils by me at any time heretofore made, I have hereunto subscribed my hand and affixed my seal to this my last will and testament this 27th day of February, A. D. 1903.
