In the name of God Amain this 8th day of January 1822

I Marey Leathem of York District State of South Carolina Being
 varelly Sick and low in body but of perfect mind and memory
 thanks be to god therefor Calling to mind the mortality of
 my body and knowing that is is appointed for Weoman once to die
 do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to
 say principally and first of all I gave and recommend my Soul
 unto the hands of almighty God that gave it and my body I
 recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Cristian
 manor at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at
 the genorel resurrection I Shall receive the Same again by the
 mighty power of god and as turning Such Wourldly Estate there-
 with it hath pleased God to bless me within this life I gave and
 Dispose of the following manner and form-----

Item I gave and bequeth to my Dauter Reachel Simons my Deeling
 hous and all the oald Clear land and the wood land that lies
 between my Cler land and his line from the upor Corner next to
 Robert Leathems down to the lower Corner of the oald field west
 the Cotton field Excepted five Bacors South East Cornor lies
 my Cauben (?) and furniture one bead and furniture and all my
 Household furniture-----

Item I gave and bequeath to my Sone Andrew Leathem the one
 half of all the rest of my wood land goining him and the Strip
 lying along the west sand to simons and John Wilsons line and
 the one half of the meadow and my pot and forty six Dollers
 that I have in hand-----

Item I gave and bequath to my Sone Robert Leathem all the other
 half of my wood land goining to himself on the East Land with

the Cotton field the South East Corner of my Clear land
and the other half of my meadow and the balance of my Cash
in hand one bead and furniture and my Cow and my Brass
Sifter-----

Item I gave and bequath to my daughter Sally French five Dollars

Item I gave bequath to my daughter Agness Wilson five Dollars for
to be paid by my daughter Reachel and Andrew and Robert-----

I also allow my Negro girl Luce for to make her Choice of my
Childring for to live with that is here and if she move away
she is to take the next Choice for she is not to be moved
from here while there is one of them here-----

Item I do likewise constitute make ordain my Son Andrew Leathem
and my Son Robert Leathem my Sol Executors of this my last
will and testament and I do utterly disallow revoke and dis-
annul all and every other former testaments wills legacies and
bequaths Cartifying--and Confirming this and no other to be
my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
Set my hand and Seal this the 8th day of January 1822
