Secondly I leave and bequeath to my two Daughters Elizabeth Sadler and Margaret Lowry All my beds and clothing of Every description whatever and all my household and kitchen furniture and all personal property whatever to be Equally divided <sup>between</sup> them

Thirldy and lastly I do hear by nominate constitute and appoint Elizabeth Sadler and Margaret Lowry Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking and disanulling all former Wills and Testaments Acknowledging this my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal This Third day of May one Thousand Eight hundred and Twenty Nine
