MARY STEELE
STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

In the amen of God, Amen I Mary Steele of York District, South Carolina being far advanced in life & being of infirm body yet hopefully of sound mind, do make this my last Will and Testament. Viz I commit my Soul to God who gave it, and my body to the earth whence it came to be interred in a Christian manner. As to my earthly property it is my will after the payment of my just debts, that three hundred dollars of the proceeds of the sale thereof be paid to My daughter Anne; and the balance to be equally divided between my Son Joseph & my Daughters Viney & Margaret.

To carry these provisions into effect I constitute my Son Joseph Steele Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament. Witness my hand and seal this 12th August 1835.
